



College of Arts & Media Scholarship Guide & Application As of FALL 2007

General Guidelines

- Students are required to submit complete packets for each scholarship for which they are applying with the top sheet being the application coversheet.
- If you are submitting CDs, slides, portfolio, etc. and are applying for more than one scholarship that requires the same example of work, only one set/copy is required – do not submit duplicates.
- Recipients must attend one (1) CAM event (e.g., Open House, etc.) as a student representative for **each** scholarship that they are awarded.
- Students may only receive a specific scholarship award for two (2) consecutive semesters. (The student may reapply for the scholarship after one semester of not receiving an award.)
- If additional requirements are noted in individual scholarships, students are responsible for adhering to all listed requirements (e.g., reports, meetings, service, etc.).
- The total value of any combined scholarship cannot exceed the tuition being charged to that student in the current semester.
- CAM does not accept responsibility for materials submitted.
- Students are responsible for ensuring that letters of recommendations arrive before the deadline.
- Include high school and/or college transcripts where a minimum GPA is required (unofficial, web printouts or photocopies are acceptable).
- Upon graduation and once in a financial position to do so, scholarship recipients are encouraged to help fund scholarships (in any amount) for current students.
- *Incomplete applications will not be considered* (including but not limited to missing/incomplete Application Form, missing materials – e.g., resume, etc.).

Deadlines

- Application packets should be submitted to ARTS 177 by 5pm on April 1st.
- Should March 1 fall on a weekend, please have submission submitted the Friday before.

Portfolios

- Examples of work may be picked up in ARTS 177 after the Scholarship Committee has met.
- Other submissions (e.g., application packet) will not be returned.
- If you are applying for multiple scholarships that require work submitted, you only have to submit one portfolio (unless the portfolio requirements are different).

The John & Rose Berg Memorial Scholarship for Freshmen

College of Arts & Media Transfer Student Scholarship

Marriott. Five \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded in each of the following disciplines: Music, Theatre, Visual Arts, and Film Production (one per discipline area). All scholarships are based on the following prioritized criterion: 1) artistic ability; 2) academic performance; and 3) financial need. The maximum scholarship may not exceed full resident tuition and fees for the enrolled credit hours plus 10% of that amount for a book allowance. Scholarship is awarded half in Fall and half in Spring.

QUALIFICATIONS

- **Marriott.** Must be a graduate from a public school high school in Denver, Adams, Jefferson, Douglas, or Arapahoe County. Preference is given to students from Denver School of the Arts.
- **Berg.** Must be a graduate from a public school high school within Colorado.
- **Transfer Students.** Earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 in previous college coursework if having completed 30 or more semester hours. Earned a minimum of a 3.25 High School GPA if transferring with 29 or fewer semester hours.
- Classified as a Colorado Resident for tuition assessment purposes.
- Accepted in the University of Colorado at Denver and the College of Arts and Media.
- Have a declared major within the College of Arts & Media (Music; Theatre, Film, & Video Production; Visual Arts).

REQUIREMENTS

- Be enrolled for at least 6 semester credits for the period of the scholarship.
- Maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher during the period of the scholarship.
- May be asked to complete a designated project within the student's discipline, which may involve the department, its students or the Denver community.
- May be asked to attend an event to meet with the donors.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete & submit a CAM Scholarship Application Coversheet.
- Include a resume listing specific performances, showings, workshops, and class work you have done in your discipline.
- Write a one to two page essay, responding to the following prompt: "The CAM mission is help students see themselves working in the arts and culture industries after they graduate—and to have this vision from their first day on campus as a CAM major. Describe how you see yourself working in the arts after you graduate, and how do you see the program you are enrolled in helping you to achieve this goal."

DEADLINE: April 1st for Fall award
December 1st for Spring award (Transfer Student Scholarship only)

All CAM Majors

Dean's Fellowship

This fellowship is awarded during the Spring semesters, to be applied to the student's subsequent Fall and Spring semester's tuition. The award amount varies from \$500.00 to \$2,500.00 for each semester the award is given.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Enrolled, degree-seeking student in their first undergraduate program. Students pursuing their second bachelor's degree are not eligible for this award.
- Declared major within Arts & Media.
- Completed a minimum of 30 UCDHSC credits with a minimum GPA of at least 3.0. at the time of application.
- Classified as a Colorado Resident (for tuition purposes).
- Cannot be receiving either Regent's Scholarship or a Colorado Scholars Award.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete & submit a CAM Scholarship Application Coversheet.
- Write a one to two page essay, responding to the following prompt: "The CAM mission is help students see themselves working in the arts and culture industries after they graduate—and to have this vision from their first day on campus as a CAM major. Describe how you see yourself working in the arts after you graduate, and how do you see the program you are enrolled in helping you to achieve this goal."
- Include a resume detailing your work in the arts and campus or community service.

Brown Scholarship

Award amount is \$250.00 - \$500.00 and is awarded for fall and spring semesters.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Enrolled degree seeking in the College of Arts & Media.
- 3.00 minimum cumulative GPA.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete a CAM Scholarship Application Coversheet.
- Submit a resume detailing work in the Arts.

Arts Bridge Scholarship

Award amount is \$1,250 and is awarded only for Spring Semester. Deadline: November 1st

QUALIFICATIONS

- Degree seeking studio in the College of Arts & Media.
- 60 credits hours completed at the time of application.
- Selection based on interview with the Dean.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete a CAM Scholarship Application Coversheet.
- Submit a resume of work in the arts field.
- Submit examples of your work (e.g., slides, photographs, etc.)

REQUIREMENTS

- Student must submit down-payment by the date noted in the award letter.
- This Scholarship is intended only for students participating in the Arts Bridge program. In this program students will work collaboratively with grade school art teachers to teach art programs in the public schools.

Scholarships for Visual Arts Students

Digital Animation Center (DAC) Research Fellowship

Award amount is \$2000.00 and is awarded in Fall and Spring semesters. Students may reapply for this scholarship each semester and are exempt from the award limitation noted in the Scholarship Guidelines.

QUALIFICATIONS

- BFA in Fine Arts student with a declared emphasis in 3D Animation.
- Must have completed at least 30 semester credits, of which six (6) must be DAC credits at the time of application. Minimum 3.0 cumulative CU GPA.
- Students must be registered for at least three (3) DAC credits during the semester in which the award is applied.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete a CAM Scholarship Application Coversheet.
- Submit a 1 page resume including your academic, professional, community, and artistic work.
- Submit 3 examples of your work (still or animated), properly labeled (please note which software needed for viewing).

Write a one to two page essay, responding to the following prompt: "The CAM mission is help students see themselves working in the arts and culture industries after they graduate—and to have this vision from their first day on campus as a CAM major. Describe how you see yourself working in the arts after you graduate, and how do you see the program you are enrolled in helping you to achieve this goal."

FELLOWSHIP REPORT

- At the completion of the semester in which students receive the award, they must submit a 3 page, double spaced paper summarizing their artistic achievements during the semester and include at least one image by the last day of the semester in the award is applied. A block on any future award and registration will be placed on the student's account until this has been received.

Visual Arts Study Abroad Scholarship

This scholarship is for UCDHSC students who are planning to take Visual Arts study abroad courses in the Summer session. The scholarship amount varies and will be advertised prior to scholarship deadline. Scholarship amount will be applied directly to tuition for the study abroad.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Any College of Arts and Media student enrolled in the current semester may apply.
- Students must satisfy the prerequisites for the study abroad program to which they apply.

REQUIREMENTS

- Student must submit down-payment by the date noted in the award letter.
- The scholarship must be used for the Summer Visual Arts Department Study Abroad programs. If a student awarded the scholarship cannot complete the course in semester for which it is awarded, the scholarship will pass to another candidate.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete the CAM Scholarship Application Coversheet.
- One page essay addressing how this cultural travel experience and particular study abroad program will benefit you, your work, and your career in art.

Scholarships for Music Majors

Barney Scholarship

This scholarship provides support to students pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Music in the College's MEIS Department. Such support recognizes that the direct cost of education that includes tuition, books, and fees is significant. With the opportunities for internship, professional conference and convention participation extending these costs beyond the financial means of many students, this fund is intended to identify and support meritorious students in completing their education and maximizing their professional preparation. This scholarship is awarded for the Spring and Fall semesters. The amount of the award varies (\$1,000.00 preferred minimum) and is applicable only to the semester for which it is awarded. Funds will be applied directly to tuition.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Junior or Senior level Arts & Media Music majors (no less than 90 semester credit hours).
- Preference is given to students pursuing a BS in Music who are studying in the Recording Arts area and who have demonstrated artistic excellence, business savvy and aptitude for application of technology in music
- Enrolled as a degree-seeking student.
- 3.25 minimum cumulative GPA in current coursework.

REQUIREMENTS

- Students may be asked to submit a letter and/or examples of their work, or attend a meeting with the donors.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete a CAM Scholarship Application Coversheet.
- Submit a letter of application and a current resume of work in the music field.
- Submit tapes/CDs or scores of musical work.

Donna Bogard Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded for the Spring and Fall semesters. The amount of the award varies from \$100.00 - \$500.00 and is applicable only to the semester for which it is awarded. Funds will be applied directly to tuition.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Freshmen, Transfer, or current Arts & Media students majoring in Music.
- Principle instrument must be voice.
- Enrolled as a degree-seeking student.
- 3.0 minimum cumulative GPA in current coursework.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete a CAM Scholarship Application Coversheet.
- Submit a current resume including musical experience, references, and contact information.
- Perform an audition (auditions held during juried recitals)

Signature Ensemble

A select group of ensembles are deemed "signature ensembles" that play at additional events as College representatives. Students who successfully audition and are enrolled in a signature ensemble may be eligible to receive this scholarship. Students are nominated by the faculty to receive the award. This scholarship is awarded for the Spring and Fall semesters. The amount of the award varies from \$200.00 - 250.00 and is applicable only to the semester for which it is awarded. Funds will be applied directly to tuition.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be currently enrolled as a UCDSHC student with a declared Music Major.
- Must demonstrate outstanding performance skills.
- Must be enrolled in a signature ensemble the semester for which the student receives the award.
- Must be in good academic standing.

HOW TO APPLY

- Awardees are nominated by the Ensemble faculty. No formal application is needed

Milton Bailey Scholarship for Voice

This Scholarship is awarded on a nomination basis in the Fall and Spring semesters. While preference is given to tenors, all vocal students may be considered. The award amount of \$250.00 - \$375.00 is applicable directly to tuition in which the award is received.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be currently enrolled as a UCDHSC Music Major.
- Must demonstrate outstanding performance skills.
- Must be enrolled in applied voice during the semester for which the student receives the award.
- Must have a minimum CU cumulative GPA of 3.0.

REQUIREMENTS

- Students will be required to submit a letter of thanks and may also be asked to attend a meeting with the donors. A performance at the church, as part of a regular Sunday morning service, is required at least once during the period of scholarship award. Typically, this performance is paid by the church. Students will consult with Dr. Judith Coe re: dates and repertoire.

HOW TO APPLY

- Awardees are nominated by the Vocal faculty. No formal application is needed.
